Laurie Harden-Currently working as a freelance illustrator. Some of her clients have included Harper Collins, Ladies Home Journal, McGraw-Hill, Redbook, the New York Times, Scholastic and Simon & Schuster. An Award winner, her work has been featured in local galleries and venues in NY & NJ. She has won a number of Best in Show prizes. The National Cancer Institute, Sloan Kettering Hospital and St. Barnabas Hospital have some of her paintings in their collection.

Mark de Mos- An elected member of the New Jersey Watercolor Society as well as a signature member of the North East Watercolor Society in Kent, CT, the Garden State and Baltimore Water Societies. In addition, he has concentrated on pastel studies. His aim was to enable him to acquire a different perspective on the use and understanding of color, value, intensity and texture. He became the 1st President of the Pastel Society of NJ. Recipient of numerous awards and honors –nationally and locally, his artwork has been featured in publications of North Light Press entitled “The Best of Watercolors, Splash 8 and Splash 9.”

Ann Taylor – Award winning artist, explores watercolor techniques with emphasis on Wet-on-wet brushing, washes, masking out, composition and value. She has a B.A. in Fine & Applied Arts from Brooklyn College in Brooklyn, N.Y. Further studies in NYC included courses at the New School for Social Research and the School of Visual Arts as well as The Yard School in Montclair, N.J. She has had several solo exhibits in this area. She is a signature member of the NJ Watercolor Society, the Garden State Watercolor Society and the Pastel Society of NJ. She is also a member of the North East Watercolor Society.

Evan Stuart Marshall - Award-winning artist Evan Stuart Marshall is best known for his whimsical, vividly colored mixed-media abstract paintings. His work has been featured in many juried exhibitions, both solo and group, and is held in many private collections around the world. One of Evan's pieces was recently acquired the renowned curator and art consultant Paige Powell (once a member of Andy Warhol's Factory) for the MC Hotel in Montclair. His work is carried by major national retailers, including Homesquare, Houzz, Kmart and Wayfair. Evan is active in several art organizations including the Livingston Arts Association, Studio Montclair and the West Essex Art Association, on whose board he serves as membership chair. He lives and works in Roseland.

Tim Maher - Primary medium is oil, but also enjoys working in watercolor and pastel. His interest is in figure and portraiture, usually in a realistic, contemporary environment. He considers himself a classical painter with an occasional impressionist leaning. The current president of the Art Centre of New Jersey (located at Riker Hill in Livingston). He graduated from Rider College (now University) with a B.A. in Fine Arts/ Studio and Design Studied at the Art Students League in New York with Harvey Dinnerstein. His work has been exhibited throughout the state and has won numerous awards.

Donna Grande – Donna is a graduate of Montclair State University and has a design degree from F.I.T. She also studied at the Art Students League of New York and has established a noteworthy career as an artist over the last 30 years. Donna has won numerous awards for her paintings, has been included in many juried exhibits and galleries, has presented numerous solo shows in the Northeast, and has been featured on NBC and Fox News.

Carol Lynn Nellen- A Certified Art Teacher for Grades k-12, has taught in the West Orange Public School System since 1970. She attended William Paterson University of NJ and the University of New Hampshire where she was graduated with a B.S. in Art Education and also received her Teaching certification. She also earned graduate credits at Montclair State University, Kean University, Upsala College and Fairleigh Dickinson University.
